during his natural life, and after the death

<sup>and</sup> devise said above described lots to my beloved

Solomon P. Sisk, <sup>by a former husband</sup> Minnie L. Conner, Richard  
J. Vardaman, Leta M. Beall, <sup>and</sup> William
