I Mary Vardiman of Shelby county and state of Kentucky to the clerk of county and state aforesaid this is to certify and authorise you to issue and grant to Samuel Miles of Shelby county and state aforesaid license for the purpose of uniting according to law in the lawful ties of matrimony being about the age of thirty seven in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal.

This shall oblige us our heirs ? to be held and firmly bound unto the commonwealth of Kentucky in the just and full sum of 50 pounds for the payment of which we bind ourselves our heirs ? jointly ? given under our hands and seals this 31st day of March 1823 rendered however upon condition there shall be no lawful cause to obstruct the marriage of Samuel Miles and Mary Vardaman widow of Thomas Vardman dcsd.

Then this obligation to be ? otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
