# Vardiman Wedding Vows in Springfield

Wedding vows were exchanged by Miss Billie Francile Vardiman and John William Vardiman in a ceremony Saturday evening, August 9, in the Baptist Student Center Chapel of Southwest Missouri State College, Springfield. Rev. Hugh Wamble of Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Kansas City, read the double ring vows before the altar decorated with candelabra and two basket arrangements of white stock and cream daisies, centered with a long stemmed yellow rose.

The bride is the daughter of Mrs. Phillip Harris Vardiman of Cape Girardeau and the late Dr. Vardiman. The groom is the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Wesley Vardiman of Marshall.

Miss Ruth Huey, organist, accompanied Mrs. Carl Johnson, Cape Girardeau, as she sang, "Because" and "Bless This House."

The bride, escorted to the altar by her brother, Capt. Larry Vardiman of Scott Air Force Base, Belleville, Ill., wore a two piece floor length gown of white batiste with bodice inserts of white lace and trim of ivory satin, fashioned with a high neckline and long full sleeves, accented with lace at the wrists. The skirt was semi - full and flowing to a long sweep train to the right side. The underskirt was full, with an elaborate lace ruffle. An ivory silk pongee cumerbund highlighted the waistline. The gown had been worn by her grandmother, Mrs. Grace Carter of Kentucky, at her wedding. Her long veil was of ivory net caught with a pearl comb.
