RATE GROUP REPORTS MAJOR ADVANCES

During its sixth annual meeting in San Diego this summer the RATE group reported several findings which could lead to major corrections to the age of the earth estimates. Drs. Steve Austin, John Baumgardner, Gene Chaffin, Don De Young, Russell Humphreys, Andrew Snelling, and Larry Vardiman met over two days in July to report advances and discuss research plans.

Five major results were reported during the meeting. In-depth reports on each of these topics and several others will be included in papers to be presented by the RATE scientists at the Fifth International Conference on Creationism in Pittsburgh next summer. A brief summary of each major finding is provided below:

1. The diffusion rate of helium from zircons embedded in granite is so high that most of the helium produced by the nuclear decay of uranium to lead will escape the zircons and enter the atmosphere in less than ten thousand years. This result is based on the measurement of helium diffusion from zircons in the laboratory. The old earth timetable cannot account for the helium still trapped in the zircons.

2. Radiohalos produced by the decay of uranium to polonium and then to helium in granite samples from Flood-deposited rocks appear to have formed rapidly during the Genesis Flood (in a short period of time only a few thousand years ago). They also provide evidence that "millions" of years of decay products formed within the last few thousand years. This means that nuclear decay was much faster during the Flood than today and radioactive dating techniques and results which assume a constant decay are in error.

- 3. Isochron data of radioactive isotopes in samples taken from all over the earth show that alpha decay gives consistently younger ages than beta decay. It isn't clear yet why this is true, but it is probably a hint about processes of nuclear decay which may help us to understand how nuclear decay was accelerated.
- 4. Reports in the conventional scientific literature indicate that Accelerator Mass Spectroscopy measurement of carbon-14 in coal, oil, "old" bones, etc. all show low, but measurable concentrations of C-14. Biogenic samples should have no C-14 left if they lived millions of years ago. This means their real age is much less than thought. The conventional scientific community is reporting these results but ignoring the implications.
- 5. RATE has found theoretical reasons to believe that nuclear decay rates can change and probably have changed. When the decay rate changes, other "constants" like the speed of light, the gravitational constant, and Plank's constant likely also change.

These results have the potential for earth-shaking changes in geochronology. The group was enthusiastic about the results being found and encouraged that the Lord had allowed so much progress to be made since the project started in 1997. However, at least \$100,000 in new donations will be needed to cover the anticipated laboratory and other expenses for RATE through June, 2003. Additional funds will also be needed over the remaining three years to complete all the planned research and publish the final book in 2005. 


From E-mail
